Dear Atlas Hills Neighbor,

The County Government is illegally prohibiting Clinton Brown, CEO of Atlas, from building Atlas Hills *or* anything else on his property.<sup>1</sup> Clinton Brown, Self-Represented, was forced to sue the County Government in Federal Court on December 17, 2022. *See* ECF No. 145 for the latest Federal Court ruling on March 15, 2024.<sup>2</sup>

Congress has made clear that...no law, rule, regulation, or order, or other administrative action of any state or any political subdivision thereof... shall directly or indirectly apply... *See* 15 U.S.C. § 77r(a)(1); *See generally* JOBS Act, Pub. L. No. 112-106, 126 Stat. 306 (2012) (archived at https://perma.cc/KU4D-8YXC)

What Can We Do? 20 of the 200 Investment Contracts must be sold to start moving dirt.<sup>3</sup>

Commit 50,000 as a security to purchase *1 of the 20* investment contracts & your home will be built at the builder's cost— with no markup.<sup>4</sup>

## Phase II

On April 30, 2024, Atlas will start "moving the dirt" for the development of Atlas Hills. *See* <u>Amended Atlas Hills Phase I March 31, 2024 Deadline</u>.

Last, you are a pivotal partner in overcoming the barriers to housing imposed by regulatory takings by the County Government. Your investment directly contributes to the development of Atlas Hills, enabling Atlas to see this project through one **Phase** at a time.
